## VIEW TO A THRILL

Glamorous Hanson Bay eco-lodge set for March opening.

**KANGAROO ISLAND** With floor-to-ceiling windows offering panoramic views over the rugged Kangaroo Island coastline, Southern Ocean Lodge, due to open in March next year, is shaping up to be the next big thing on the Australian tourism landscape. Located in secluded Hanson Bay on the island's south-west coast, the 21-suite escape being developed by Baillie Lodges, the group behind the chic refurbishment of Lord Howe Island's Capella Lodge, will feature dramatic glass-walled bathrooms and outdoor terraces offering five-star views from a clifftop location. The \$15 million resort, which adjoins both the Flinders Chase and Kelly Hill National Parks, is being built with a sustainable tourism ethos, including an environmentally sensitive low-level design. Rates will be from \$900 per person, per night including breakfast, light lunch, four-course dinner, beverages, mini bar and local guided tours.
